- **Keep Right**
- **Turn right**
- **Give way to the right**
- **Don't cross the traffic flow**
- **Don't overtake**
- **Keep a safe distance**
- **Keep a good lookout**
- **Be responsible with alcohol consumption**

Check your lights

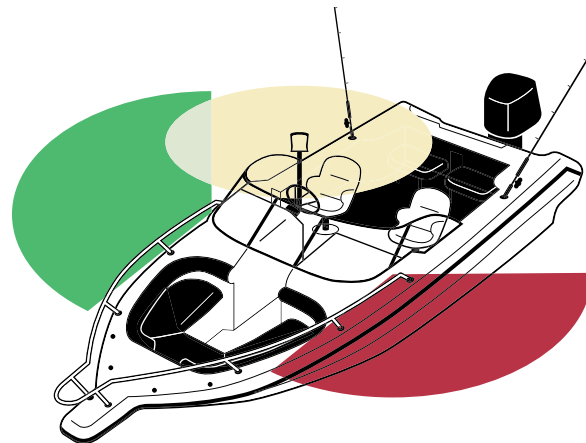
Navigation lights are required to be displayed from sunset to sunrise.

Check that your navigational lights are working and are correct for your type of vessel.

Vessels are not to display any lights that cause interference or confusion to required navigation lights or vessels. Vessels can't display spot lights at any time while navigating.
